Sunday 26 November: Our final meeting for the year - see details above.

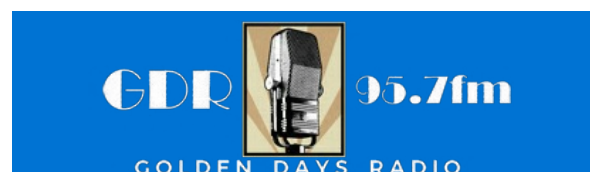
CATHS EFTPOS FACILITIES
